

DPD PHASE II, 5 Cell Battery Insertion Instructions



Position your 5 cell battery pack all the way to the left with the negative terminal facing the display.

The batteries positive terminal must face away from the display and contact the pins in this port.



Your DPD Phase II Discharger will now discharge and condition 5 cell matched battery packs. The discharging process is exactly the same as when processing 4 and 6 cell battery packs. The only difference is placement of the battery pack in the DPD discharger. Your battery pack has to be loaded using the five ports on the left. The negative battery terminal must face the display and the positive terminal must face up. Just follow the pictures above and you will have no problems.

The DPD is recognized as “state of the art” when it comes Ni-MH battery recharging and conditioning.
