Mobgum Pink lifts on initial corner. Mobgums HT has completely no lift, but shows 1.3mm wear per run. Glueing the sidewalls of the front tire stops the car from lifting but takes a way a lot of steering. Therefor going from 20% soak to 80% soak is a must and still understears. Protoform AMR lifts a bit more then Black Art BA005. Giving the car a little bit more caster made it lift les in the slower corners and made it a bit more stable.
