<u>Comments</u>

Battery in transverse layout.

Car feels really good. Switched from 10K in the tubes to 5k Wich gave it a lot more rotation, but doesn't lift the wheel that much. Also tried 3K lube, but wasn't sure if I where faster with it. I think the 5K gave a little better feeling.

Also swtiched from battery all the way to the rear, to Al the way to the front which gives the car les initial but more midcorner steering. Tried several roll-outs, but between 72 / 74 mm is best.

Whipe tires clean 10 min before the start of the race.

Gold rear tires start to give good feeling after 3 laps. So make sure they are rubbed dry before the start.

Tested 0.8 and 1.2 mm poddroop, but 1.0 gave best feeling.

Pink rear tires don't seem to work. Magenta works, but does't give the same solid feeling and starts to diff out.
