



E4RS II - Tip 6: Servo Fixation on Servo Post


One usual problem is the perfect servo fixation on the servo post.

The servo cases fixation aren't designed to be used as we do in many RC cars. So the fixation holes are a lot larger than the screw we use, as they are designed for small rubber inserts that we don't use in electric competition touring cars.

Personally, I use small spacers between the servo screws and the servo case. It allows me to perfectly prevent servo case fixations from damages due to screw misalignment.

These spacers are 3x5mm (diameters) and they perfectly fits Sanwa, Futaba and probably many other servos as well.
